Mr. Marceaux reported that the Finance Committee met on Monday, April 6, 2020, at 7:00 A.M. All bills were reviewed and declared in order with the Committee recommending payment on April 8, 2020.

Finally, Mr. Marceaux made the motion, seconded by Mr. LaFargue, and carried, to ratify approving the change to the Jefferson Davis Parish Police Jury Office pay scale as presented.

The motion was made by Mr. Marceaux, seconded by Mr. Fruge, and carried, to approve Pay Request No. 5 in the amount of \$76,356.90 to Petron LLC., to be paid out of Division One funds for the Lake Arthur Yard.

Mr. Marceaux made the motion, seconded by Mr. Cormier, and carried, to approve Pay Request No. 2 in the amount of \$20,880.00 to Keiland Construction LLC., to be paid out of Division One funds for the Lake Arthur Yard.

It was moved by Mr. Fruge, seconded by Mr. LaFargue, and carried, to approve Pay Request No.1 in the amount of \$1,281,725.86 for the FY2019 Road Improvement Project to be paid out of Road Sales Tax District No. 1.

The motion was made by Mr. Cormier, seconded by Mr. LaFargue, and carried, to approve Pay Request No. 1 in the amount of \$23,370.00 to L.K. Breaux and Associates for the new Fire District No. 1 station to be paid out of Fire District No. 1.

Mr. LaFargue made the motion, seconded by Mr. Buller, and carried, to authorize the Secretary Treasurer to advertise in connection with semi-annual supplies.

It was moved by Mr. Talbot, seconded by Mr. Buller, and carried, to approve Change Order No. 6 for the FY2019 Road Improvement project in connection with Windmill Lane, Lyons Road, Farm Supply Road, and Carl Hoppe Road in the amount of \$258,907.34 to be paid out of Road Sales Tax District No. 1.

The motion was made by Mr. Buller, seconded by Mr. Guillory, and carried, to approve for Division 2-1: eight hundred fifty-five (855) Tons of Gravel for various roads and one hundred (100) Tons of #610 Limestone for various roads.

Mr. Guillory made the motion, seconded by Mr. Fruge, and carried, to approve for Division Two: seventy (70) Tons of Gravel for Murry Road and seventy (70) Tons of Gravel for Sylestine Road.

It was moved by Mr. Eastman, seconded by Mr. LaFargue, and carried, to approve the use of video conferencing for agenda meetings during a State of Emergency, with Mr. Guillory, Mr. Buller, and Ms. Myers opposing.

The motion was made by Mr. Talbot, seconded by Mr. LaFargue, and carried, to adopt the following Ordinance, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 2342

AN ORDINANCE to impose a speed limit of 15 MPH on Abell Road from Vaussine Road to Ardoin Cove Cemetery Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE POLICE JURY OF JEFFERSON DAVIS PARISH, LOUISIANA that:

The speed limit on Abell Road from Vaussine Road to Ardoin Cemetery Road shall be 15 MPH.
