The meeting was called to order by President Donald Woods. Mrs. Gary gave the Invocation, and Mr. Talbot led the Jury in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Cormier made the motion, seconded by Mr. LaFargue, and carried, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on June 10, 2020, as written and submitted.

It was moved by Mr. Guillory, seconded by Mr. LaFargue, and carried, to authorize the Jefferson Davis Parish Library to enter into a Membership Agreement with the Industrial Development Board of the City of Jennings for shared space at 137 North Main Street, Jennings.

The motion was made by Mr. Eastman, seconded by Mr. Cormier, and carried, to authorize the President to enter into a Joint Service Agreement with the City of Jennings for the funding of the Jefferson Davis Parish Health Unit.

Ms. Myers made the motion, seconded by Mr. Eastman, and carried, to authorize the President to enter into a Joint Service Agreement with the Council on Aging for patient transportation.

It was moved by Mr. LaFargue, seconded by Mr. Buller, and carried, to authorize the President to enter into a Joint Service Agreement with the Gravity Drainage District No. 9 for bridge material.

The motion was made by Mr. Talbot, seconded by Mr. Cormier, and carried, to approve the Amanda Papion Subdivision located on Moreau Road.

Mr. Buller made the motion, seconded by Mr. Talbot, and carried, to approve the F & C Denison Ranch Subdivision Phase 10 and the F & C Denison Ranch Subdivision Phase 11.

It was moved by Mr. LaFargue, seconded by Mr. Cormier, and carried, to approve for Division Three: one (1) 36" x 38' arched asphalt coated pipe for Atterberry Road at a cost of \$2,018.18 and one thousand two hundred ninety (1,290) Tons of gravel for various roads.

The motion was made by Mr. Buller, seconded by Mr. Cormier, and carried, to approve for Special Revenue: one (1) John Deere 76 G Excavator to lease for \$1,580.00 per month for four (4) years.

Mr. Eastman discussed the issue of No Wake Zone signs being placed on the banks at Houssiere Park and disappearing. Wildlife and Fisheries suggests using buoys. Mr. Eastman made the motion, seconded by Mr. Fruge, and carried, to give the Courthouse Superintendent and Road Supervisor the authority to order buoys to correct the issue.
