The current contracts in place with DRC Emergency Services for debris pickup and Thompson Consulting Services for monitoring for the parish and the four (4) municipalities who are contracted with the Police Jury expires today. Therefore, advertising took place for Request for Proposals through 2021. Proposals were received on Wednesday, September 30, 2020 and scored.

Two (2) proposals were received for debris pickup. Upon reviewing the score sheets, Mr. Buller made the motion, seconded by Mr. Fruge, and unanimously carried, to accept the Proposal from KDF Enterprises LLC for debris pickup.

There were three (3) proposals received for debris monitoring. Upon review of the score sheets, the motion was made by Mr. LaFargue, seconded by Mr. Talbot, and unanimously carried, to accept the Proposal from Tetra Tech for debris monitoring.

It was moved by Mr. Buller, seconded by Mr. Eastman, and carried, to allow the municipalities to participate under the contracts through Memorandums of Understanding should they elect to do so.

It is the consensus of the Police Jury to have a representative of KDF and Tetra Tech, as well as each electrical utility company serving residents in the parish, to attend the Agenda meeting on Wednesday, October 7, 2020.

There being no further business to come before the Jury, it was moved by Mr. LaFargue, seconded by Mr. Talbot, and carried, to adjourn the meeting.
