The motion was made by Mr. Woods, seconded by Mr. Peterson, and carried, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on March 23, 2022, as written and submitted.

Mr. Marceaux reported the Finance Committee meeting was held on Monday, April 11, 2022 at 7:00 A.M. All bills were reviewed and declared in order with the Committee recommending approval.

It was moved by Mr. Marceaux, seconded by Mr. Woods, and carried, to pay the following bills, to wit:

Mr. Woods made the motion, seconded by Mr. Buller, and carried, to accept the resignation of Civirillian Morvant from the Fire District No. 1 board and to further send a Letter of Appreciation to Mr. Morvant for his service.

It was moved by Mr. Buller, seconded by Mr. Guillory, and carried, to approve a request from Ted Savant to cut across Parish Line Road to install an underground irrigation pipe to access the Charlie Istre Farm.

The motion was made by Mr. Guillory, seconded by Ms. Myers, and carried, to approve a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement and Donation between the Jeff Davis Police Jury and the Town of Welsh whereby the Town is donating a tract of land for the Jeff Davis Parish Library to build a new Welsh branch and to further authorize the President to sign all related documents.

Mr. Marceaux made the motion, seconded by Mr. Woods, and carried, to reappoint David Trahan and Cory Conner to the Broadmore Drainage District board with terms expiring April 13, 2026.

It was moved by Mr. Woods, seconded by Mr. Marceaux, and carried, t reappoint Sidney Theriot and Jerry Hartwell to the Gravity Drainage District No. 1 Sub A board wither terms expiring April 13, 2026.

The Police Jury resolved itself into the Zoning Commission Board of Review to receive public comments in connection with a request received from Peyton and Priscilla Fullilove for a change in zoning classification from A-1 to C-1 for a multipurpose venue rental building located at 7102 Hwy 26, Jennings, in Section 34, Township 10 South, Range 3 West. No public comments were received.

Mr. Marceaux made the motion, seconded by Mr. Woods, and carried to approve the change in zoning classification.

The motion was made by Mr. McKnight, seconded by Mr. Marceaux, and carried, to accept the Zoning Commission Board of Review's recommendation as stated, to adopt the following Ordinance, to-wit:

The motion was made by Mr. Woods, seconded by Mr. Peterson, and carried, to authorize Fire District No. 4 to enter into a seven (7) year Lease Purchase Agreement with Republic First National for the purchase of a Firetruck with a down payment of \$50,000.00 and to further authorize the President to sign all related documents.

Mr. Woods made the motion, seconded by Mr. Fruge, and carried, to approve for Division One: 80 Tons #57 Limestone for Royer Road, and accept a quote from Danny Landry to clear trees and dig a ditch on Morgan Shores Road at a cost of \$2,360.00

It was moved by Mr. Marceaux, seconded by Mr. Guillory, and carried, to ratify the action of the Agenda Committee in adopting the following Resolution, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the Jefferson Davis Parish Police Jury incurs costs in advertising minutes in the Official Journal;

WHEREAS, the Jefferson Davis Parish Police Jury intends to have a parish website in which it will post its meeting minutes;

WHEREAS, SB322 presented by Senator Fred Mills, will allow posting of minutes electronically by amending La. Rev. Stat. 43:151.

WHEREAS, with the passing of SB322, the Jefferson Davis Parish Police Jury will be able to save costs from advertising meeting minutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jefferson Davis Parish Police Jury in a duly convened session on April 6, 2022, as follows:

1. We, the members of the Police Jury, do hereby support the passage of SB322 and direct the Secretary to send a copy of this Resolution to its legislators and to the appropriate committee.

This resolution was declared adopted on April 6, 2022 and ratified on April 13, 2022.

The motion was made by Mr. Peterson, seconded by Mr. Guillory, and carried, to appoint Vicki Kebodeaux to the Fire District No. 1 board to fill the unexpired term of Civirillian Morvant, which expires December 31, 2023.

Committee Reports

Mr. Woods reported a Courthouse Committee meeting held on April 6, 2022 at 4:15 pm. The Courthouse Committee made the recommendation to accept the low base bid of \$583,977.00 received from Daughdrill Roofing to change the Courthouse roof.

The motion was made by Mr. Woods, seconded by Mr. Guillory, and carried, to accept the bid from Daughdrill Roofing.

Mr. Fruge reported a Fairgrounds Committee meeting held on April 6, 2022 at 5:15 pm. The Fairgrounds Committee recommending making the following changes to the Rental fee schedule: a) Non-school and Professional Rodeos and other events - \$50.00 per hour with a maximum of \$500.00 per day and No Deposit required, remove tractor and operator rental fee, cleanup fee down to \$150.00, and b) Whole Park Rental fee - \$1,000.00 per day and \$500.00 Deposit.

It was moved by Mr. Fruge, seconded by Mr. Buller, and carried, to accept the changes as recommended.

Mr. McKnight reported OEP Committee meetings held on March 23, 2022 at 5:30 pm and April 13, 2022 at 4:15 pm. The OEP Committee recommends giving Marcus Peterson authority to move forward with putting together a PEMAC Committee.

The motion was made by Mr. McKnight, seconded by Mr. Guillory, and carried,

to accept the Committee's recommendation as stated.

The OEP Committee also recommends granting authority to Marcus Peterson to

order radios and to apply for reimbursement through the OEP grant.

Mr. McKnight made the motion, seconded by Mr. Buller, and carried, to accept

the Committee's recommendation.

Finally, the OEP Committee recommends authorizing the Secretary to advertise

for Request for Proposals for Debris Removal and Debris Monitoring services contingent

upon Legal Counsel approval.

It was moved by Mr. McKnight, seconded by Ms. Myers, and carried, to accept

the Committee's recommendation.

Mr. Woods made the motion, seconded by Mr. McKnight, and carried, to

authorize Bluewing Civil Consulting to send a Notice of Award to Daughdrill General

Contracting in connection with the replacement of the Courthouse roof.

Carolyn Barker requested consideration of removing the rice drier located on

North Cutting Avenue. The building and property were adjudicated in 2019 with the

Parish owning 80% and the City of Jennings owning 20%.

A motion was made by Mr. Peterson, seconded by Mr. Adams, and carried, to

have the Parish Road Crew remove the chaff shaft and have area secured.

Mr. Fruge made the motion, seconded by Mr. Adams, and carried, to authorize

Legal Counsel to research whether the building can be torn down.

There being no further business to come before the Jury, it was moved by Mr.

Woods, seconded by Mr. Peterson, and carried, to adjourn the meeting.
