A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING SUPPORT FOR APPLICATION TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF FACILITY PLANNING AND CONTROL, 2023-2024 CAPITAL OUTLAY PROGRAM FOR A GRANT TO BE USED FOR EXPANSION OF WATER SYSTEM FOR NEW DEVELOPMENT

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Jennings, Louisiana, duly convened in regular session with a quorum present and voting that:

WHEREAS, the City of Jennings is desirous of enhancing economic development opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jennings strives wherever possible to improve its facilities, buildings and infrastructure to better meet the needs of the public it serves; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Jennings needs the financial assistance of the State of Louisiana through the Office of Facility Planning and Control, Capital Outlay Program to achieve these measures;

Expansion of water system for new development in the City of Jennings
(\$1,660,000 plus local funds of \$550,000)

to be used for WATER SYSTEM EXPANSION for the City of Jennings.
